

# Questions About Whether Evil Angels Can Impregnate Human Females

Pastor Ed - we're amazed we stumbled on you on YouTube. I'm the one who sent the question last night about demons and evil angels. Our church is Pentecostal here in the Deep South and we are watching you intently. We have never heard such profound good news from the book of Revelation. Some of us here are looking for the people you identified. Please help us find God's people. Thank you! But some of us here are scared out of our wits about getting attacked and even impregnated by evil angels. Is that even such a thing? Is that biblical? Our pastor alludes to this often citing the Nephilim.

## Answer:

Absolutely, and thank you for sharing such a heartfelt message. What a blessing to hear that God is using our Revelation seminar to bring light to your church family in the Deep South!

Let's address your question biblically and clearly:

## **Can Evil Angels Impregnate Humans Today?**

**Short Answer: No. There is no biblical evidence that this is happening now or that it's even possible.**

Your concern is rooted in **Genesis 6**, where it says:

"The sons of God saw that the daughters of men were beautiful, and they took wives for themselves." — *Genesis 6:2*

This is the verse many link to the **Nephilim**, or giants. But let's unpack this properly and biblically:

## **Two Views on Genesis 6**

### **1. Angels Marrying Women?**

Some believe that “sons of God” were fallen angels who had children with human women—creating the Nephilim. This idea:

## 2. The Faithful vs. the Worldly View (the correct biblical interpretation)

- “**Sons of God**” = godly descendants of Seth (those who worshipped the true God).
- “**Daughters of men**” = worldly descendants of Cain (those who rejected God).
- The union = spiritual compromise that led to widespread evil.

“Then the Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great...” — *Genesis 6:5*

This understanding:

- Keeps the Bible in harmony.
- Does not require angels to biologically procreate.
- Explains the rise of wickedness before the Flood without mythological baggage.

## So What Are Demons and Evil Angels?

- **Demons = fallen angels**. They were cast out of heaven with Satan (Revelation 12:7–9).
- They:
- **Tempt**
- **Deceive**
- **Possess (if allowed)**
- **Distort God’s truth**
- But they **cannot reproduce or impregnate people**. That’s **spiritual fear-mongering**, not Bible truth.

## What About the Fear of Attack?

If your group is feeling scared of demonic attacks or infiltration, please rest in this truth:

“You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.” — *1 John 4:4*

**You are sealed, protected, and covered** by the blood of Jesus when you walk with Him. There is no fear in love. Perfect love casts out fear (1 John 4:18).

### **Beware of Spiritual Hysteria**

Many well-meaning pastors or traditions teach **fear-based doctrines** like:

- Demonic pregnancies
- Nephilim children today
- Ongoing half-angel hybrids

But these are **not taught in Scripture**. They lead to **confusion, fear, and spiritual anxiety**, not faith, peace, and truth.

### **What Should You Focus On?**

1. **Jesus, not Nephilim**
  - The book of Revelation is not about horror—it’s about **hope**.
2. **Victory, not Vulnerability**
  - Jesus already defeated Satan at the cross (Colossians 2:15).
  - Demons **tremble** at His name.
3. **Faith, not Fear**
  - “The Lord is my light and my salvation—whom shall I fear?” — *Psalms 27:1*

### **Final Word**

Satan wants to **distract God’s people** from the true message of Revelation with:

- End-time conspiracy
- Obsession with spiritual attacks
- Fear of demonic power

But **Revelation is about a Lamb who wins**. Not demons who scare.
