1. Start with Scripture

Everything prophetic must be rooted in God's Word. Study passages such as:

- **1 Corinthians 12–14** spiritual gifts, especially prophecy, in the context of love and order.
- Romans 12:6 prophecy according to faith.
- **Ephesians 4:11–13** gifts given to build up the body of Christ.
- **Deuteronomy 18:21–22** tests for genuine prophecy.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:19–21 "Do not despise prophecies, but test everything."

2. Cultivate Intimacy with God

Prophetic sensitivity grows from closeness with God.

Spend consistent time in prayer, fasting, and quiet listening.

The purpose of prophecy is not prediction — it's **revelation for transformation** (John 16:13).
