# Questions About Who Resurrected Jesus from His Grave

Who resurrected Jesus from His grave?

#### Answer:

Great question — and one that reveals the mystery and power of the **Triune God** in perfect unity.

The Bible reveals that all three persons of the Godhead were involved in the resurrection of Jesus:

## God the Father Raised Jesus

- Romans 6:4 "Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father..."
- Galatians 1:1 "Paul, an apostle... through Jesus Christ and God the Father. who raised Him from the dead."
- Acts 2:24 "But God raised Him up, having loosed the pains of death..."

This shows the **Father's active role** in resurrecting Jesus, affirming His divine approval and acceptance of the atoning sacrifice.

#### Jesus Raised Himself

- John 10:17–18 "I lay down My life, that I may take it again. No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again."
- John 2:19–21 "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up... But He was speaking of the temple of His body."

This affirms Jesus' divine authority and self-existence — that even in death, He retained the power over life.

## The Holy Spirit Raised Jesus

- Romans 8:11 "But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ... will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you."
- 1 Peter 3:18 "... being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit."

The **Holy Spirit**, the power and breath of God, also participated in giving life back to Jesus' body.
