Questions About Whether There Are Days of Week and Sabbath in Heaven

In heaven, right now, are there days of the week? Or, is heaven an eternal Sabbath day?

Answer:

This is a powerful question—one that invites us to reflect on both the nature of **eternity** and the significance of the **Sabbath** in heaven.

Let's explore it from a biblical and theological perspective.

IS HEAVEN AN ETERNAL SABBATH?

Yes—in spirit and rest, heaven is an eternal Sabbath.

In Hebrews 4. Paul writes:

"There remains therefore a rest to the people of God."

— *Hebrews 4:9 (KJV)*

The Greek word for "rest" here is $\sigma\alpha\beta\beta\alpha\pi\sigma\mu\delta\varsigma$ (sabbatismos) — which literally means *Sabbath rest*. The implication is that eternal life with God is the **ultimate** fulfillment of what the seventh-day Sabbath pointed toward:

"For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as God did from his."

— *Hebrews 4:10*

In heaven, the struggle, labor, and burden of earthly life will cease. We will finally experience **perfect communion with God**, which the Sabbath has always symbolized.

BUT—ARE THERE DAYS OF THE WEEK IN HEAVEN RIGHT NOW?

Yes—Time Still Exists in Heaven (for now)

Although heaven is eternal, time in some sense **still operates**:

1. Revelation 22:2 says:

"...and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. In the midst... there was the tree of life, which bore twelve fruits, yielding its fruit every **month**..."

This tells us **months** still exist in heaven—or at least, in the new earth. That means some form of **sequence** and **measurement** of time still operates.

2. Isaiah 66:22–23 (New Earth Prophecy):

"For as the new heavens and the new earth... from one **Sabbath to another**, shall all flesh come to worship before me, saith the

This is **very clear**—Sabbath remains **in eternity** as a perpetual day of worship. There will still be **weekly worship cycles**, even in the new earth.

3. The 24 Elders in Revelation:

Lord."

They worship God **continually**—"day and night" (Revelation 4:8)—which suggests that **heaven is aware of day/night rhythm** at least until the final judgment and restoration.

THEOLOGICAL INSIGHT

• The Sabbath on Earth = a symbolic rest

It's a shadow pointing to the **eternal rest** we will enjoy in the presence of God (Colossians 2:16–17, Hebrews 4).

• In Heaven = a spiritual Sabbath state

No sin, no toil, no burdens, no fear. That's why we call it a "Sabbath of Sabbaths." Every moment is *holy delight*.

ELLEN WHITE ON SABBATH IN HEAVEN

"The Sabbath was not for Israel merely, but for the world. It had been made known to man in Eden, and, like the other precepts of the decalogue, it is of imperishable obligation... In the new earth the Sabbath will be observed to all eternity."

— The Desire of Ages, p. 283

"In the earth made new the redeemed will engage in the occupations and pleasures that brought happiness to Adam and Eve... Every week, the faithful of every nation will come to worship together before God on the Sabbath."

— Prophets and Kings, p. 730
