

Questions About Bible Promises of Protection During Seven Plagues

Psalm 91:3-10

protection from 1st plague - Painful, loathsome sores break out on people who have the mark of the beast.

Isaiah 33:16

protection from 2nd plague - The sea turns to blood, and every living creature in it dies.

Isaiah 41:17-18

protection from 3rd plague - The rivers and springs of water turn to blood.

Psalm 91:1-4

protection from 4th plague - The sun scorches people with its intense heat, causing them to curse God.

Psalm 121

protection from 4th plague - The sun scorches people with its intense heat, causing them to curse God.

Psalm 27

protection from 5th plague - Darkness and pain overwhelm the kingdom of the beast. People gnaw their tongues in agony but still refuse to repent.

Micah 7:8

protection from 5th plague - Darkness and pain overwhelm the kingdom of the beast. People gnaw their tongues in agony but still refuse to repent.

1 John 1:5-7

protection from 5th plague - Darkness and pain overwhelm the kingdom of the beast. People gnaw their tongues in agony but still refuse to repent.

2 Corinthians 10:4

protection from 6th plague - The river Euphrates is dried up to allow kings from the east to cross and march to Armageddon.

Ephesians 6:10-17

protection from 6th plague - The river Euphrates is dried up to allow kings from the east to cross and march to Armageddon.

Isaiah 54:14-17

protection from 6th plague - The river Euphrates is dried up to allow kings from the east to cross and march to Armageddon.

Isaiah 26:20-21

protection from 7th plague - This is poured into the air, resulting in a great earthquake, the collapse of cities, and giant hailstones falling on people. This leads to the final battle at Armageddon.
