Questions About Identifying Marks of God's Church (People)

Based on the following points below, is the pastor saying that the Seventh-Day Adventist Church is Gods church in the last days?

- 1. Keep the commandments including the sabbath
- 2. Have the gift of prophecy
- 3. Came up after 1798 according to the Daniel prophecies
- 4. Global movement
- 5. Preaching judgment hour has come
- 6. Preach three angels messages

Or any other points?

Answer:

Yes, based on those points, the pastor is very likely identifying the Seventh-day Adventist Church as God's end-time remnant church according to its own prophetic understanding and interpretation of Scripture.

Let's walk through each point and how the Seventh-day Adventist (SDA) Church connects it directly to **Revelation 12**, **Revelation 14**, and the **book of Daniel**:

1. Keep the Commandments — including the Sabbath

- Revelation 12:17 describes the remnant as:
- "...those who keep the commandments of God and have the testimony of Jesus Christ."
- The SDA Church teaches that keeping **all Ten Commandments**, including the **seventh-day Sabbath (Saturday)**, is a visible sign of loyalty to God (see Exodus 20:8–11).

2. Have the Gift of Prophecy

- The "testimony of Jesus" is defined in Revelation 19:10 as: "the spirit of prophecy."
- Adventists apply this to the **prophetic gift**, especially as manifested in the ministry of **Ellen G. White**, one of the co-founders of the church.

3. Came Up After 1798 According to the Daniel Prophecies

- Daniel 7:25 and 12:7 describe **1,260 prophetic days (years)** during which the "little horn" power persecutes.
- This period is interpreted as ending in **1798** when the Pope was taken captive by Napoleon's general.
- The SDA Church began to form shortly **after 1844**, during the **Millerite Movement** and after the **Great Disappointment**, aligning with the prophetic timeline.

4. Global Movement

Revelation 14:6 says:

"Then I saw another angel flying in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach to those who dwell on the earth—to every nation, tribe, tongue, and people."

• The SDA Church is one of the **most globally widespread Protestant movements**, present in over **200 countries**.

5. Preaching 'The Hour of His Judgment Has Come'

- This is a direct quote from Revelation 14:7.
- Adventists believe this refers to the **pre-Advent judgment** (also known as the **Investigative Judgment**) that began in **1844**, based on their interpretation of Daniel 8:14:

"Unto 2,300 days; then shall the sanctuary be cleansed."

• They claim this is a **unique message** not widely taught outside the SDA Church.

6. Preach the Three Angels' Messages

- The messages of Revelation 14:6–12 calling people to:
- Fear God
- Give glory to Him
- Worship the Creator (linked to the Sabbath)
- Reject Babylon (apostate religion)
- Avoid receiving the mark of the beast
- The SDA Church teaches it is the **only denomination with a full, prophetic, global message specifically centered on the Three Angels' Messages**.

So, Is the Pastor Saying the SDA Church Is God's End-Time Church?

Yes — by listing these prophetic identifiers, the pastor is aligning with **traditional Seventh-day Adventist teaching** that the SDA Church **fulfills the characteristics** of the **"remnant church"** described in **Revelation 12:17 and Revelation 14**.

Other typical identifying markers the church may add include:

- Belief in Jesus as our High Priest in the Heavenly Sanctuary
- Baptism by immersion
- Health message and holistic gospel (often called "the right arm of the message")
 - Preparing people for Christ's soon Second Coming

Important Note:

This does not mean Adventists believe only Adventists are saved, but rather that they have a special, end-time prophetic role to proclaim God's last message of mercy and warning to the world.
