# Question About the Position of Letters in the Tetragrammaton

In the Tetragrammaton, the relationship between Hebrew letters must be extremely significantly...is there a meaning and purpose to the letter Vav being positioned between two Heh's? Is the Lord God Almighty saying something important by the placement of two Heh's in the Tetragrammaton? What do the letters of the Tetragrammaton teach us about the nature and character of the Godhead?

#### Answer:

This is a profoundly important question—and yes, the placement and repetition of the letters in the Tetragrammaton (יהוה – Yod-Heh-Vav-Heh) are incredibly significant. Every letter in God's revealed Name carries theological and mystical weight, and their sequence and repetition unveil deep truths about the nature of God, the character of the Godhead, and how God reveals Himself to humanity.

## THE TETRAGRAMMATON: יהוה (Yod-Heh-Vav-Heh)

Let's explore each letter in its sequence—and then the deeper meaning of the pattern *Heh-Vav-Heh*.

## 1. Yod (¬) – "The Divine Spark, the Hidden Hand of God"

- Shape & Meaning: A small suspended point. The smallest letter, it symbolizes the beginning of all things, divine intent, and creation from the unseen.
- Spiritual Insight: You represents God's power to initiate and the source of all reality. It is the seed from which all things grow, just as creation came from the Word.
- In Christ: Jesus is called "the Beginning" and "the Word". He is the Yod—the spark of divine life that enters the world (John 1:1–4).

## 2. Heh $(\pi)$ – "Revelation, Breath, and Grace"

• Shape & Meaning: A window or an open space. Represents breath, revelation, and expression. It often signifies God's Spirit revealing Himself to the world.

- **Spiritual Insight**: Heh is the **opening**, the **Spirit-breathed revelation** of God to creation. This is how God **makes Himself known**.
- In Christ: Jesus is the exact image and revelation of God (Hebrews 1:3). Through Him, we see the Heh—God made visible and personal.

## 3. Vav (1) – "Connection, Nail, or Hook"

- Shape & Meaning: A straight vertical line. Literally means "hook" or "nail." It symbolizes connection between heaven and earth, or man and God.
- Spiritual Insight: Vav connects. In Hebrew grammar, it also functions as a conjunction ("and"), joining ideas. Vav is the link between the divine and the physical.
- In Christ: Jesus is the Vav—the "Mediator between God and man" (1 Timothy 2:5). He was nailed to the cross—literally a Vav—to reconnect earth to heaven.

## 4. Final Heh (7) – "The Final Revelation and Restored Creation"

- **Repeated Letter**: Heh is used **twice**—and this is intentional.
- The second Heh can represent the **revealed glory of God at the end**, **redemption**, and the **Spirit dwelling among us** fully.
- It also hints at **spiritual rebirth**—as Abraham's name changed from *Abram* (אברם) to *Abraham* (אברהם) with the addition of **Heh**, symbolizing **God's breath** entering his life.

#### THE STRUCTURE: Y-H-V-H

Let's now look at the **overall pattern**:

יהוה = Yod 
$$\rightarrow$$
 Heh  $\rightarrow$  Vav  $\rightarrow$  Heh

This can be seen as:

- 1. **Yod** (\*) The *unseen divine spark* of God's infinite power.
- 2. **Heh**  $(\pi)$  The *initial revelation* of that power to mankind.
- 3. **Vav (1)** The *connecting nail*, or the *incarnate mediator* who links heaven and earth.
- 4. **Heh** ( $\pi$ ) The *completed revelation*, the *Spirit of God dwelling among us*, the *Bride made ready* (Revelation 21:3).

#### THEOLOGICAL CONCLUSION: What YHVH Reveals About the Godhead

#### **Profound Truth:**

YHVH teaches that the God who is above all (Yod), reveals Himself (Heh), connects to us through the Son (Vav), and ultimately restores and dwells among us (final Heh).

### Messianic Insight:

- The **Vav between the Hehs** is Jesus—the **pierced One**, suspended between **two revelations** of the Father.
- Jesus is the Connector (Vav) between God's invisible glory (Yod) and His indwelling Spirit (Heh).
- Thus, **the fullness of the Godhead** dwells **bodily** in Jesus Christ (Colossians 2:9)—a truth coded into the very **Name of God**.

#### FINAL THOUGHT

The repetition of Heh shows us that the **revelation of God is not a one-time event**, but a **process**—first revealed (1st Heh), **joined to us** (Vav), and then **fully revealed and glorified** (2nd Heh). This sequence mirrors our journey of salvation: **from revelation**, to **union with Christ**, to **glorification** and dwelling in God's presence forever.
