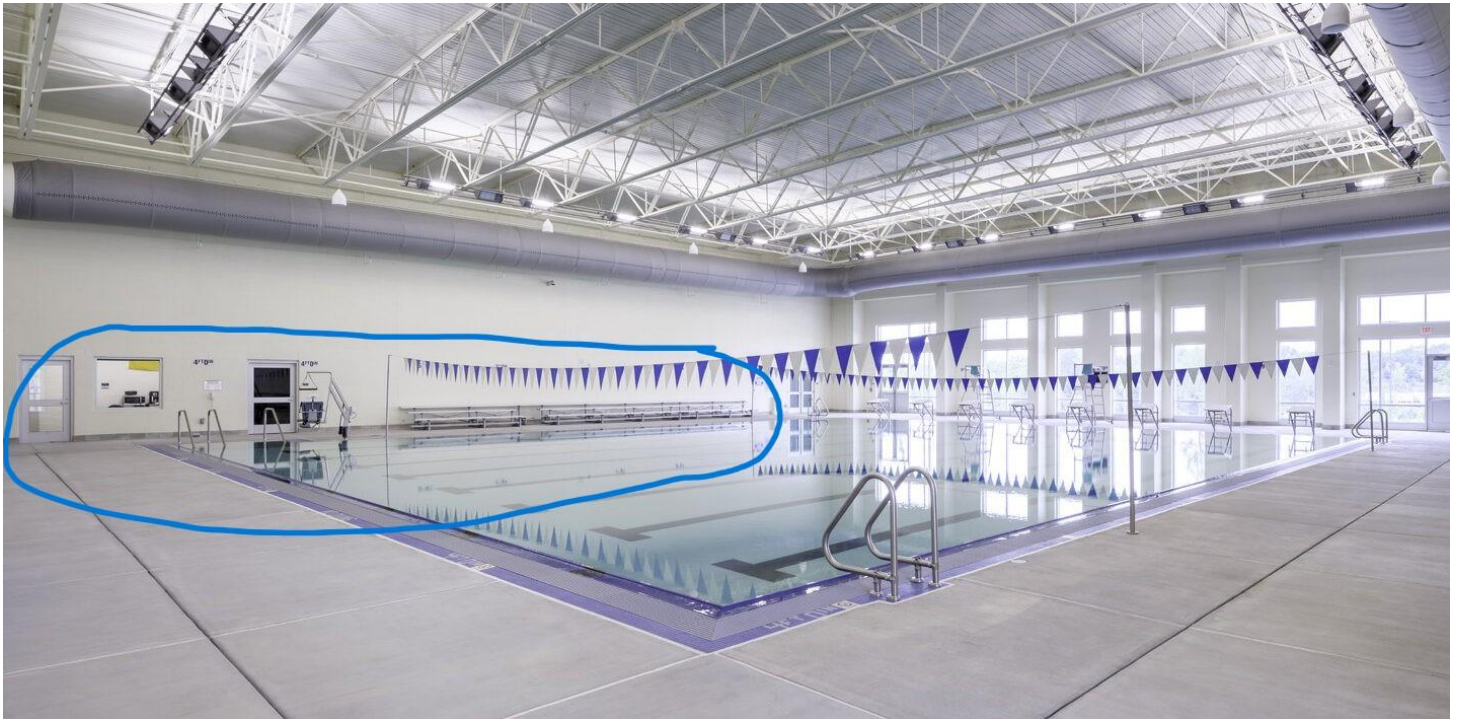

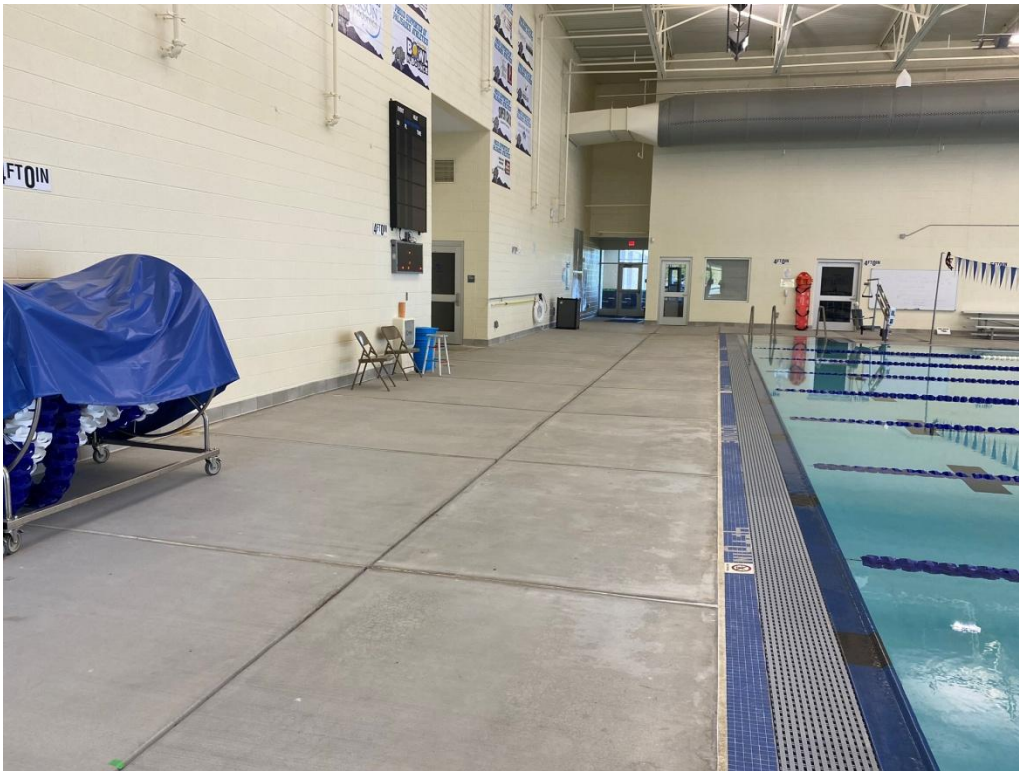


1. Entrance door for ALL spectators and swimmers for teams Crossings, Chapel Cove, McCullough, Huntington Forest and Planters Walk
2. Outside patio team area for Berewick, Palisades & River Hills

*ALL cars MUST be parked in a parking spot or risk being ticketed and towed.



Spectator seating circled in blue. There will be additional spectator seating at the end of the pool. Spectators may bring folding chairs for seating.



Spectator seating will be available at the end of the pool. Personal chair use is permitted. The hallway leading to the locker rooms will be taped off so swimmers have access to the locker rooms for use.

Locker rooms will be where the swimmers will access bathrooms. **No swimmers will be allowed in the school hallways.**



We will be swimming in Lanes 1-6. Starter station and the Computer station will be in the top corner past the spectator seating area, adjacent to Lane 1.

Lanes 7/8 will only be used for warm-ups.

Team Seating Areas



1. Chapel Cove – the far corner and the first part of the bleachers
2. McCullough
3. Huntington Forest
4. Crossings
5. Planters Walk



1. Berewick
2. Palisades
3. River Hills

The patio area will be shaded during our swim meet.
Outside teams are free to bring their own canopies for additional shade.

The inside pool area is hot/humid so dress accordingly.

Pool notes

- Palisades High School pool is an 8-lane, 25yards pool. We will be competing in Lanes 1-6. The Meet will be run in YARDS. Events will swim gender-combined as they have all season. Results will be provided (gender-specific) in Yards and also a SCM conversion report.
- There will be designated areas for each - swimmers and spectators.
- Spectators will not be allowed in the swimmers' area.
- Spectators may bring fold up chairs for overflow seating.
- Teams that are set up outside on the patio may bring your own canopy tents.
- Swimmers are to stay with their teams. They are encouraged to bring a pad or towel to sit on.
- Clerk of Course is not responsible for tracking down swimmers who have left their team area.
- Swimmers who do not report when called by the Clerk of Course may miss their event.

Parking

- The school has several large parking lots; there will be ample parking. All cars MUST be parked in a designated parking spot or risk being ticketed/towed by CMPD.

Pool Entrance

- ALL spectators and swimmers for teams Crossings, Chapel Cove, McCullough, Huntington Forest and Planters Walk will use the side entrance door noted on the first school photo.

Bathrooms/Locker Rooms

- Locker Rooms will be available for swimmer use. There are plenty of lockers inside that swimmers are free to use; locks are not provided – bring your own. Any locks left on the lockers after the meet will be cut off and disposed of.
- Swimmers will ONLY use the locker room bathrooms and are NOT permitted in the hallways.
- Spectators will have one hallway designated for bathroom use.
- The school is NOT open for wandering by anyone during our event.
- Swimmers that leave the swimmer area to use the bathroom will not be chased down by the Clerk of Course. It is the responsibility of each swimmer (or their team) to ensure attendance for events.

Food/Drink/Clean-up Fee

- Concessions will NOT be available for purchase. Attendees are allowed to bring their own food. All trash must be discarded and swimmer areas/spectator areas are to be trash-free at the completion of the swim meet. Teams that have trash left in their swimmer area will be assessed a \$100 clean-up fee that will need to be paid in full prior to registration for the 2025 season.
- Team Chaperones are responsible for monitoring swimmers and ensuring that the team areas are clean before departure.

MISC

- Each team should bring a box for award collection at the end of the meet
- Results will be posted as they become finalized
