



HerStory Agreements

Please read the following Agreements that align with our goals and vision at HerStory. All participants must sign these Agreements prior to being in our annual drawing.

1. I agree to interview the person whose name is drawn to be my muse in person or online no matter what their age, race, abilities, background, religion, or sexual orientation is. There will be two categories of HerStory participation, one for teens and one for adults. All participants identify their gender as female whether that was their gender assigned at their birth or not.
2. I agree to interview the person whose name is drawn to be my muse with the understanding that they will likely have different life experiences, educational paths, career choices, and family structures than my own.
3. I agree that diversity of the participants promotes a strong circle of connections amongst local artists.
4. I agree to enter into this year's annual drawing with a growth mindset, curiosity, love, and acceptance.
5. I agree to create art in the medium or expression of my choice for the person whose name I drew to be my muse. I must present something visual and tangible for my muse to have as her gift to remember this experience by. I may choose to create an additional gift for my muse in a different art form even though I am not required to. My art will be wired appropriately (information will be given), if on a 2-D surface, to be hung in our collective art show by March 1, 2025 for those in the Northern Colorado area. If I live outside of Northern Colorado, my art will be sent directly by me to my muse after I have captured my art digitally and sent it to herstoryconnects@gmail.com
6. I agree to be interviewed by the person I am acting as a muse for so that she may create an expression of art for me.
7. I agree that there are factors beyond my control when dealing with other people and circumstances. I will not hold HerStory responsible for an artist who does not create their artwork for me for any reason.
8. I agree to hold whatever stories my muse tells me privately and will not share any of their information with others.
9. I agree that although privacy is expected and agreed upon, it can never be guaranteed and therefore understand that it is a possibility that my interviewer may knowingly or unknowingly share part or all of my story with someone else.
10. I agree to be who I get to be and do what I get to do to make this a positive experience for myself and others, and to engage with others with an open mind and heart since I am a part of co-creating HerStory.
