iCheck-In

Little Possums is excited to introduce the iCheck-In process this week.

You may have noticed an iPad on the front desk in a silver case. This will allow you to electronically mark your children as 'In' and 'out' with just a PIN. When you first use the system it will ask for your mobile number, then a security PIN will be sent to your phone. With this PIN you will be able to access your child/rens enrolment and sign them in.

Each authorised parent, guardian or friend listed on your enrolment will have the ability to generate a PIN with their mobile number (or landline). This may be a good time to check that your list of caregivers is up-to-date!

This system ensures accurate records of arrival and departure times are recorded and also increases the sustainability of our centre by removing the need for paper based forms and double handling of information.

Zucchini Slice

This is one of the easiest recipes you will ever find!
Perfect for lunch box fillers or afternoon tea it is ready in a flash with cheap and easy to find ingredients.



375g Zucchini

1 large brown onion

3 rashers of bacon (rind removed)

1 cup grated cheddar cheese (or whatever is in the fridge)

1 cup self-raising flour

1/2 oil (vegetable will be fine)

5 eggs

Salt & pepper

Method

Grate unpeeled zucchini coarsely, finely chop bacon and onion. Lightly beat eggs in a bowl and then add zucchini, onion, bacon, cheese, sifted flour, oil and season with salt and pepper. Pour into a well greased lamination tin (base measures 16cm x 26cm), bake in moderate oven for 30 - 40 minutes or until browned. Serve warm or cold.

This recipe also freezes well.
