# **Docu+ Announces New Trailer for Documentary Zero Waste**

SUWON, SOUTH KOREA, June 7, 2021 - Zero Waste is a character-driven social impact documentary looking closely at four individuals who are coming up with creative solutions to address the plastic waste problem in South Korea.

Currently in production, Zero Waste was made possible by the incredible hospitality of artists, activists, and urban ecologists who are changemakers in South Korea today. From artist studios to refill stations, they discovered a common mission. Small individuals working together to voice their environmental concerns is the only way to move large corporations and government policymakers.

The documentary is targeted to be released in June 2022 and has successfully raised 32.5% of the total budget (\$100K) and looking to raise the remaining 70% or \$70K by Fall 2021. The director is currently working with award-winning sound mixer Lee Tae Kyu (*Whispering Corridors, Tae Guek Ki*) and Kim Wook (*Black Money, Namyeong-dong 1985*) as the lighting designer/gaffer. The documentary intends to inspire many individuals to affect change at the local and international level to fight plastic pollution.


#### Excerpt from the film:
