
All photos must follow the category guidelines specifically and must include mosquitoes and/or closely related arthropods including but not limited to spiders, centipedes, millipedes, scorpions, isopods, etc. unless otherwise indicated in the category submission description/directions.

All the submissions must be completed using the links on the following pages. Each caption must include a "Title" and can include a brief description if desired.


The same photo cannot be submitted for multiple categories (excluding "Mosquito Best in Show" & "Overall Best in Show.")

How to add a "Title & Description"

- 1. After your photo is uploaded, click on the newly uploaded photo.
- 2. Navigate to the "Info" icon in the upper left corner of the page. (As demonstrated below)



3. Add a photo title/description. (As demonstrated below)



4. Close the "Info" box and you can now close out the page.

VMCA Photo Contest Categories

1. Under the Scope (\$20.00 prize)

- a. Get up close and personal with your subject.
- b. Submit a microscope or macro lens photo.
- c. Pictures must be only of organisms (as primary focus).





2. Research (\$20.00 prize)

- a. Submit a photo that visually introduces or communicates a research project or lab experience.
- b. Must be an arthropod/mosquito related research project.





3. Mosquito Outreach (\$20.00 prize)

a. Submit a photo that demonstrates public outreach efforts.

4. Original Meme (\$20.00 prize)

- a. Entry must include an original photo.
- b. Meme must include text.
- c. Meme must include a mosquito.
- d. Be creative and appropriate.

5. Mosquito Interactions (\$20.00 prize)

- a. Entry must focus on an interaction between mosquitoes, plants, animals, fixtures, and/or other environmental elements.
- b. Submission must visually communicate something about mosquito behavior and/or ecology, at any stage of its life cycle, to the viewer(s).

6. Got Mosquitoes? (\$20.00 prize)

a. Submit a photo of an area of land covered in man-made containers that can hold a large number of mosquito larvae.

7. Trap Set Up (\$20.00 prize)

- a. Submit a photo of equipment/ traps used to collect mosquitoes or arthropods.
- b. Submission may be of the equipment/trap in the field, en route to trap sites, or in the lab/office.

8. Innovation that Excites (\$20.00 prize)


a. Entry must demonstrate a creative innovation or solution to a problem that was encountered in the field, office, or lab.

- b. Not limited to mosquito only photos.
