sollicitans disturb; annoy; worry; make anxious (L.) taeniorhynchus banded snout or beak (Gr.) triseriatus three series or rows (L.) trivittatus three ways; a crossroads (L.)

vexans annoying (L.)

Anopheles: troublesome (Gr.)









barberi bearded (L.) crucians cross; torture (L.) *punctipennis* a sting; prick; feather; wing (L.) *quadrimaculatus* four-spotted (L.)

Coquilletidia: named for Coquillet



perturbans disturb; ruckus (L.)



Culex: a gnat; small fly (L.)



salinarius of salt; salty (L.) **territans** terror (L.)

restuans renewing; reviving (L.)

erraticus pipiens wandering (L.) peeping; chirping (L.) quinquefasciatus five-banded (L.)

Culiseta: little bristle (L.)

melanura black-tailed (Gr.)

inornata unadorned (L.)

Orthopodomyia: straight-footed fly (Gr.)



signifera wildly-marked, signed (L.)



Psorophora: itch-bearing; scabies (Gr.)









ciliata small hair (L.) columbiae of Columbia; dove (L.) *howardii* named for Howard **ferox** fierce; wild; savage (L.)

Toxorhynchites: bowed snout or beak (Gr.)



rutilus red (L.)

Uranotaenia: heavenly bands or ribbons (Gr.)



sapphirina sapphire; blue (Gr.)
