

January 27, 2021

The 2021 Annual Business meeting of the Virginia Mosquito Control Association was held virtually through GoToMeeting on January 27, 2021.

President Elect Tim DuBois called the meeting to order at 12:46 pm.

Motion was made by Mitch Burcham, seconded by Ann Herring, to accept the business meeting minutes from the January 30, 2020 annual business meeting as it was submitted on the VMCA registration webpage. No discussion, 17 in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

Motion was made by Betsy Hodson, seconded by Luz Grant, to accept the 2020 financial report as it was submitted on the VMCA registration webpage. No discussion, 15 in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

Committee Reports:

Annual Meeting/GoToMeeting Overview: Charles Abadam, things went well this year with only a few issues. It was a success. Alternate planning was nice to have in place. Tim DuBois said we had up to 87 logins each day, with more people if they were watching from the same screen.

Annual Meeting/Agenda: Chair Tim DuBois, the agenda come together really well. There were no problems finding speakers, and it was easy to put together. Public Relations: Chair Ryan Levering, 2020 National Mosquito Awareness Week Proclamation paperwork went out in April, but there was never conformation from the governor's office. Hopefully the 2021 paperwork will be confirmed.

Tech Support: Chair Charles Abadam, the 2021 virtual meeting was a lot of work but really fun to set up. There were a few issues, but things seemed to go really well. Thank you to Tim, Jay, and Karen for being so helpful. It could be a good idea to do virtual events like this in the future; small symposium or webinars on different topics like pesticide resistance.

Website: Chair Karen Akaratovic, website worked out really well with posting information about the virtual meeting. Thank you to all that helped. The plan is to put PDFs of the presentations on the website.

Student Competition: Chair Jay Kiser, even with a weird year, we were able to hold a student poster competition. There was less participation than we expected, but we were happy to host it and had a great first place poster from Na Xie. We are planning on having our 3rd Annual Tour de Skeeter on June 19, 2021. Please be on the lookout for registration emails. A huge thank you to the committee members for all their hard work.

MAMCA: Representative Elizabeth Hodson, my three years as representative have come to an end. Jeff Hottenstien will be taking over the position. February 17-18, MAMCA will be having a free virtual
