

# Proposed changes to the VMCA By-Laws

Article XIII, Section 1 states that changes to the bylaws must be approved by the executive board and sent to the membership at least 30 days prior to the annual meeting. Below are the changes to the bylaws recommended by the board. These will be discussed and voted on at the annual meeting; a 2/3 vote of the members present is needed for passage. In the amended section below, additions are indicated in **bold**, red text.

#### Article V Officers and Committees

#### Section 1. Officers

A. The association officers shall consist of the president, president elect, vice president, first vice\_president,\_secretary treasurer, and current past president. <u>The MAMCA representative</u>, <u>Sustaining member/Industry representative</u> and <u>TMVCC chairperson are</u> <u>special non-voting officers</u>. *Amended Feb. 14, 1997*.

#### Article VII. Nomination and Election of Officers

**Section 1.** Nominating Committee. The nominating committee shall be established annually and will be chaired by the current or serving past president.

Section 2. The nominating committee shall submit to the executive committee its nomination(s) for each office to be filled in the ensuing year. All nominations, including write-in candidates, shall carry the consent of the nominee and assurance that they will serve if elected.

**Sections 3.** The nominating committee chairperson shall prepare an election ballot containing the names of the nominees for offices with space for write-in candidates for each office. The ballot shall:

- Be reviewed and approved by the VMCA executive board and sent to all voting members at least six weeks prior to the annual meeting.
- Automatically contain the name of the President Elect as a nominee for the office of President.
- Contain at least two qualified candidates for the office of First Vice President.
- Voting must be completed before 5:00 PM the day before the annual business meeting.

New voting members or voting members who have not completed the voting process will be able to do so at the annual meeting. In the case of a tie for any elected office, the election shall be decided by the majority vote of the voting members present at the annual **business** meeting. There will be no nominations from the floor during the business meeting.


# Section 4. The sustaining members shall select a representative to sit on the Executive Board for a two year term.

*Rationale*: The Board would like to include a sustaining member/industry representative on the Executive Board. The rep should have a two-year term to be selected by the sustaining members and approved and appointed by the Board. The sustaining member rep would be a non-voting member of the board.

# York County Mosquito Control 2014 Season Trapping Recap

York County reinstated its mosquito trapping program in the 2014 season using  $CO_2$  baited CDC and BG traps. There were 116 traps set between May and September.

The top species captured was *Aedes albopictus*, accounting for 27% of the total. *Aedes albopictus* populations peaked in late August. Second was *Culex salinarius* accounting for 25% and peaking in late May. Third was *Culiseta melanura* at 17%. The *Cs. melanura* populations stayed steady throughout the season with the largest captures in September.



This figure shows the top 10 mosquito species captured in York County, Virginia between May 1 and September 30, 2014. Number of mosquitoes captured and percent of total capture are displayed for each species.
