Due to Covid-19 restrictions, CPR will be handled differently. Michigan is still requiring the BLS for Healthcare Professionals and AED CPR certification. The American

Heart Association's extension period has ended. Social distancing and indoor group gathering rules will be observed.

The training will involve a video, the exam, and preforming chest compressions. **No breaths will be given. You must wear a mask and gloves**. You can bring your own pen, but sanitized pens will be available. You can also bring your own sanitizer and water bottle; no food or beverage will be provided. The certification is good for two years. Of course, if Michigan is locked down again, this will have to be changed.

Late arrivals will not qualify for the AHA CPR card.
