

## NURSING STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

The National Association of Hispanic Nurses, Phoenix Chapter, is offering two **\$2000**, and three **\$1000** scholarships to eligible Hispanic nursing students as well as a **\$1000** scholarship that is open to Non-Hispanic nursing students. The award amount varies with the selection criteria of each scholarship. The award will be distributed half in Fall Semester and 2<sup>nd</sup> half distributed in Spring Semester directly to the student upon selection and completion of all requirements. The recipient is required to have volunteered a minimum of 6 community service hours prior to applying, and an additional 12 community service hours at NAHN events to receive 2<sup>nd</sup> distribution. *Selected applicants must plan to attend and be present during NAHN conference on August 27<sup>th</sup>*, *2021 to receive scholarship.* Scholarship application forms and eligibility criteria are enclosed. #### **PURPOSE:**

3 levels of scholarships available from NAHN, Phoenix Chapter.

The Annual General Scholarships\$1000 each

- Three General Scholarships for Hispanic Nursing students
- One General Scholarship for a Non-Hispanic Nursing student

The Bertha Sepulveda Community Service Scholarship\$2000The Ester Ruiz Academic Scholarship\$2000

The \$1,000 General scholarship award is to assist in the professional development of three Hispanic nursing students, and one Non-Hispanic nursing student pursuing academic endeavors in the nursing field. Awards will be presented at the NAHN-Phoenix annual conference.

The \$2000 *Dr. Ester Ruiz Academic Scholarship* was developed to acknowledge the Chapter Co-Founder Dr. Ester Ruiz, who has provided years of mentorship and scholarly contribution to the Hispanic community. The award is for exceptional scholarship and pursuit of graduate degrees to improve practice, research and education. Award will be presented at the NAHN-Phoenix annual conference.

The \$2000 *Bertha Sepulveda Community Service Scholarship* was developed to acknowledge the Chapter Co-Founder Bertha Sepulveda, who has provided years of mentorship, program development and community associations to promote the health of the Hispanic community. The award is for exceptional community involvement. Award will be presented at the NAHN-Phoenix annual conference.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- 1. Must be a Nursing student of Hispanic/Latino descent for the Ester Ruiz Academic Award, Bertha Sepulveda Community Service Award, and the three General Scholarships. Non-Hispanic Nursing student for one General Scholarship.
- Current NAHN-Phoenix Chapter member- 3 months or longer at the time the application is submitted and an active volunteer in the community. Students who display and are personally committed and contributing to the ongoing success and mission of NAHN will be highly considered.
- Proof of previous volunteer hours needs to be submitted with application.
  i.e. formal letter on letter head, pictures at events
- 4. When recipients have been selected, recipients will receive half the scholarship amount for the Fall semester. In order to receive the 2<sup>nd</sup> half for the Spring semester, recipients must have successfully completed 6 volunteer hours at NAHN events and tracked by outreach committee. (If you are graduating in the Fall semester, in order to receive the 2<sup>nd</sup> half, you **MUST** submit proof of graduation via transcripts official/unofficial on school letterhead and shall be used for Licensure fees.)
- 5. Must Reside in the State of Arizona
- <u>All prerequisites are completed</u> and are accepted into a <u>nursing program</u> in an <u>accredited</u> L.P.N, A.D.N., B.S.N., M.S.N. or Doctoral Program in nursing.
- 7. Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 required.
- 8. The application must be postmarked by the deadline of July 23<sup>th</sup>, 2021 or emailed to <u>nahnphxscholarships@gmail.com</u> by 23:59 of July 23<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Complete Scholarship Application
- 2. Submit current Transcripts from school enrolled in, which includes a current GPA (no handwritten GPA accepted).
- 3. Type essay to addresses the following: How can I contribute to NAHN and the Hispanic community? How will the scholarship contribute to my success as a student? The essay should be between 1000 to 1500 words, double-spaced, and grammatically correct. Originality, academic goals and NAHN-Phoenix involvement in the content is encouraged.
- 4. Additional Essay question if applying for the *Dr Ester Ruiz Academic Scholarship*: What Scholarly focus in your nursing studies have you pursued and how does it support the mission of NAHN? How do you plan to remain involved with NAHN after obtaining your degree/license?
- 5. Additional Essay question if applying for the *Bertha Sepulveda Community Scholarship*: **Describe your recent involvement in community activities as well as NAHN activities. How do you plan to remain involved in the community and NAHN after obtaining your degree/license?**
- 6. Two letters of recommendation dated within last 6 months from a Professor or adjunct faculty from school of attendance that can address why the applicant should be considered for the NAHN scholarship.

#### **RECIPIENT SELECTION:**

Selection preference is based on the following, respectively:

- 1. Completed application postmarked by July 23<sup>th</sup>, 2021
- 2. Eligibility criteria
- 3. Quality, content, and grammar of written essay
- 4. Cumulative GPA on transcript.
- 5. Must attend the NAHN Conference on August 27<sup>st</sup>, 2021
