Christ's Kingdom Already Exists

- A. Jesus is reigning now (Acts 2:29-36; Rev. 19:6, 17:14)
- B. Christ now sits on David's throne (Acts 2:30-33)
- C. The kingdom would come in the first century (Mark 9:1)
- D. John was in the kingdom during the first century (Rev. 1:9)
- E. Christ's 1,000-year reign (Rev. 20:4) began in the first century
- F. Christians are transferred in the kingdom (Col. 1:13-14)
- G. Christ reigning until all enemies destroyed (1 Cor. 15:24-26)

Premillennialism?

The Kingdom is Spiritual

- A. Christ's kingdom is spiritual, not physical (John 18:36)
- B. The kingdom is within / among people (Luke 17:20-21)
- C. Physical Israel not equivalent to spiritual Israel (Rom. 9:6-8)
- D. The church is the kingdom (Acts 2:38-47; Col. 1:13, 18, 24)

Premillennialism?

Jesus Did Not Fail

- A. Jesus successfully established His kingdom (Matt. 16:18-19)
- B. Christ now has all authority (Matt. 28:18)
- C. Christ now reigns at God's right hand (Eph. 1:20-23)
- D. Jesus is now King of kings (1 Tim. 6:15)
- E. Christ already exalted as ruler (Rev. 1:5)

Premillennialism?

Only One Resurrection Day

- A. Christ's return & end of the world = same event (1 Cor. 15:23-26)
- B. Resurrection occurs on "last day" (John 6:39-40)
- C. One future resurrection taught (Acts 24:15)
- D. Saved and lost raised together (John 5:28-29)
- E. Judgment connected with resurrection (Matt. 25:31-46)
- F. Christ will return once for judgment (Heb. 9:27-28)

Premillennialism?

Earth Will Be Destroyed

- A. Earth will be destroyed at Christ's coming (2 Pet. 3:4, 10)
- B. Earth reserved for fire (2 Pet. 3:10-12)
- C. Present creation will pass away (Matt. 24:35)
- D. Jesus will not set foot on earth upon His return (1 Thess. 4:16-17)
