Why Should I Watch My Mouth?

If we [freely] admit that we have sinned and confess our sins, He is faithful and just [true to His own nature and promises], and will forgive our sins and cleanse us <u>continually</u> from all unrighteousness [our wrongdoing,

everything not in conformity with His will and purpose].
