JADE is a tax-exempt non-profit organization based in Rialto, CA. JADE was created for public and charitable purposes to provide funding in education and humanitarian needs. JADE has developed partnerships in communities within the Inland Empire, Belize City, and rural communities of Belize to provide financial assistance in education, prepare and deliver food boxes to recipients all over Belize, offer free sewing classes, and provide transportation and spiritual support.

It is 2022. The New Year began the way it ended – with COVID restrictions due to a sharp increase in the number of COVID cases all over the country.

In-person learning for primary and high school students resumed in mid-January. On February 19, JADE hosted a Life Skills Seminar for students in high school. Topics presented were: Self-Awareness, Budgeting, and Time Management.

Recently, there has been a steady decline in the number of COVID-related cases. The curfew was lifted on March 1, and depending on the schools, students are attending classes two to three days a week.

The women's small groups are meeting in-person on Fridays. The women shared how they continue to persevere and praise God for each new day. The constant is knowing that we have an amazing, loving God who cares about us and is in control of our lives. We can trust Him.

In January, February, and March, Margie and I delivered food to the villagers. Some are surviving regardless of their situation. AB, one of the recipients, takes care of her two-year-old daughter, a younger brother, and her bed-ridden mother. She continues to trust God and is hoping that 2022 will be a better year for the family.

Applications for the new school year, 2022-2023, are now being accepted. The donations received over the next two months will determine how many families JADE can continue to serve with food and tuition assistance.




JADE is at Work with its Partners providing:
