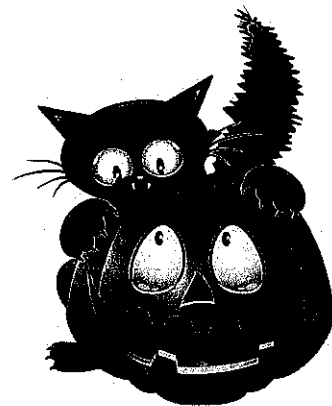

There will be no transfers from October 16th until the beginning of the year.

We are working on billing and updating some files.

Please remember when you do schedule a transfer with the office, we schedule only 2 transfers per day.

If you are transferring a title, the new owners must have their drivers license with them so the Notary can run a drivers License verification with the state of Pa. This is a requirement by the state of Pa not PPCA.

There is a \$5 fee per drivers license.

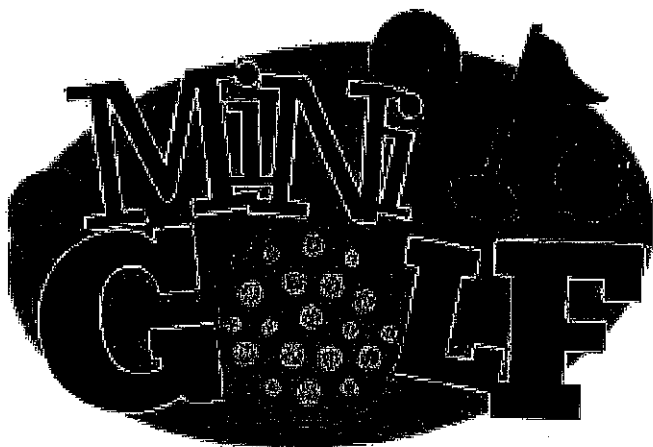


## POOL COMMITTEE
