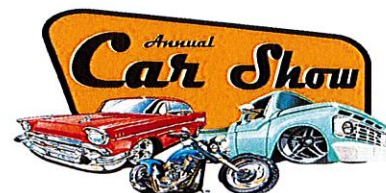

Pumpkin Butter

TOTAL TIME: Prep: 5 min. Cook: 20 min. + cooling

YIELD: 6 cups

Ingredients

- 3 cans (15 ounces each) pumpkin
- 2 cups sugar
- 1-1/2 cups water
- 3 tablespoons lemon juice
- 1 tablespoon grated lemon zest
- 3 teaspoons ground cinnamon
- 3/4 teaspoon salt
- 3/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg
3/4 teaspoon ground ginger

Directions

- 1. In a large saucepan, combine all ingredients. Bring to a boil, stirring frequently. Reduce heat; cover and simmer for 20 minutes to allow flavors to blend.
- 2. Cool. Spoon into jars. Cover and store in the refrigerator for up to 3 weeks.

BYLAWS ARTICLE II

SECTION 2. In order to maintain and operate the Campground, a Maintenance Fee will be charged at the beginning of each Fiscal Year.

The Maintenance Fee for the Fiscal Year will be as follows:

Members with one lot..... \$ 1,389.00

Members with second adjacent lot, with no
Utilities, an additional..... \$ 941.00

Members with third adjacent lot, with no
utilities, an additional..... \$ 941.00

Members with no lot..... \$1,046.00

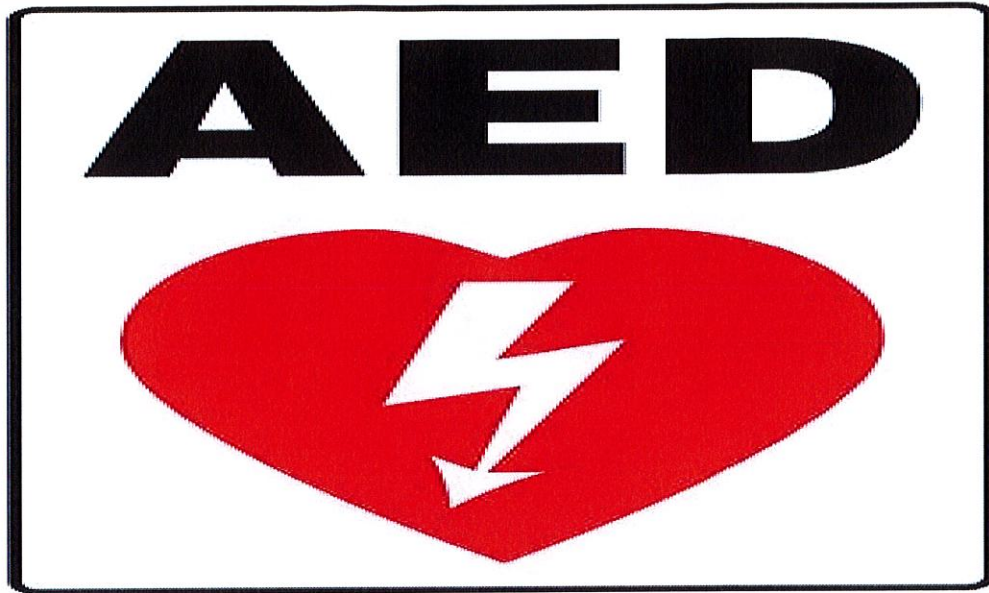
Member with 1/2 partial lot..... \$ 528.00

Maintenance fee's are due 1/2 by March 15th
and the balance by May 15th

January 1st will be marked as pre pay for 2025



The new AED machines are here!!!!

We received 3 AED machines from the Buhl foundation.
There was no cost for the park to the machines and all supplies will come from the Buhl Foundation as well if we should ever have to need them.

The machines will be located in 3 separate areas of the park and will be marked with an AED sign.

The locations we are looking at are:

Pavilion, Laundry Mat and Youth Center

We will also have our older AED machine in the clubhouse for a total of 4

We had our First training class on September 29th and 15 people attended
