BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS

Faith/Belief

*Definitions:*Breastplate

- The breast, the part of the body from the neck to the navel, where the ribs end
- A breastplate or corset consisting of two parts that protects the body on both sides from the neck to the middle

Righteousness

- In a broad sense: state of him who is as he ought to be, righteousness, the condition acceptable to God
 - a. the doctrine concerning how man may attain a state approved of God
 - b. integrity, virtue, purity of life, rightness, correctness of thinking, feeling, and acting
- In a narrower sense, justice or the virtue which gives each his due

Faith


• Conviction of the truth of anything, belief; in the NT of a conviction or belief respecting man's relationship to God and divine things, generally with the included idea of trust and holy fervour born of faith and joined with it.

A righteous man is a just man, and the just shall live by faith (Galatians 3:11, Hebrews 10:38). Both Noah and Abraham exemplified faith in God, which was credited to them as righteousness. Their RIGHTEOUSNESS was not as a result of their extraordinary deeds but rather stemmed from their unwavering faith in God. At times, one might think that (doing good) acts of kindness, such as generosity, helping the needy, preaching, bestow a certain favor with God. They are good works and we should do them as ambassadors of Christ. However, all these deeds are empty without faith. One's integrity, virtue, purity of life, thoughts, emotions, and actions, which are the metrics of righteousness (essential for being deemed acceptable to God), are attainable solely through faith in the transformative power of salvation through Christ Jesus. We can't achieve righteousness through our own merits.

Isaiah 64:6 New King James Version (NKJV)But we are all like an unclean thing, And all our righteousnesses are like filthy rags; We all fade as a leaf, And our iniquities, like the wind, Have taken us away.

Lord Jesus, I repent for walking in my righteousness; it is all like filthy rags, I let it all go; cleanse me Lord from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9).
