

Build Your Own "Father's House" Craft Activity

Objective: Help children understand the importance of building their lives on Jesus, the solid foundation, through a hands-on craft and discussion.

Materials Needed:

Shoebox or small cardboard box (to represent a house)
Construction paper, glue, scissors

Markers or crayons

Small stones or pebbles

Bible verse printouts (e.g., 1 Corinthians 3:11, Matthew 7:24)

Optional: stickers, fabric scraps, popsicle sticks

Steps:

Foundation First:

Let the kids glue small stones or pebbles to a cardboard base to represent a strong foundation. Talk about how Jesus is our foundation.

Build the House:

Decorate the shoebox to look like a house. Add windows, a roof, and doors using paper and craft materials.

Add Scripture:

Paste Bible verses on the walls of the house. Encourage kids to choose one verse that speaks to them and write it inside the house.

Discussion Time:

Ask questions like:

What makes a house strong?

What does it mean to build your life on Jesus?
How can we keep our spiritual house clean and welcoming for God?

Prayer Moment:

End with a short prayer asking God to help us build our lives on His Word and keep our hearts clean and full of His Spirit.
