- What does it mean that God is our hiding place?



The Life Cycle of a Butterfly - God's Hiding Stage Egg - The Beginning

- Just like a butterfly starts as a tiny egg, our lives begin with God's plan already inside us.
- Lesson: God sees potential in us even when we are small and unnoticed.
 Caterpillar Growth
- . The caterpillar eats and grows, preparing for what's next.
- Lesson: We grow by learning God's Word and being nourished by His truth.

Cocoon (Chrysalis) - The Hiding Stage

- The caterpillar enters a cocoon, hidden away from the world.
- It looks like nothing is happening, but inside, transformation is taking place.
- Lesson: This is like the seasons when God hides us for healing, protection, and preparation.
 - Psalm 32:7 "Thou art my hiding place; thou shalt preserve me from trouble."
 - Just as Moses was hidden in the basket and Jesus was hidden in Egypt, the cocoon is a safe place until the butterfly is ready.
