COMPLAINING



Ephesians 5:20
20 giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ,

Psalm 106:25
Then they despised the pleasant land; They did not believe His word, 25 But complained in their tents, And did not heed the voice of the Lord.

Definitions:
Murmur

- To murmur, mutter, grumble, say anything against in a low tone
- of those who confer secretly together
- of those who discontentedly complain

Destroyer

- a ruiner, i.e. (specially), a venomous serpent:—destroyer.

Destroyed

1. to destroy
 - a. to put out of the way entirely, abolish, put an end to ruin
 - b. render useless
 - c. to kill
 - d. to declare that one must be put to death
 - e. metaph. to devote or give over to eternal misery in hell
 - f. to perish, to be lost, ruined, destroyed
2. to destroy
 - a. to lose

A heart that complains about things, situations and people is stuck in the past, is rebellious, and resists growth. A heart that gives thanks trusts that “all things work together for good” (Romans 8:28). Our posture determines the results we see. Gratitude opens the door to transformation; complaining invites ruin and eventual death.
