Destroyer

• a ruiner, i.e. (specially), a venomous serpent: destroyer.

Destroyed

 - a. to put out of the way entirely, abolish, put an end to ruin
 - b. render useless
 - c. to kill
 - d. to declare that one must be put to death
 - e. metaph. to devote or give over to eternal misery in hell
 - f. to perish, to be lost, ruined, destroyed
- 2. to destroy
 - a. to lose

Symbolism

The foods, Numbers 11: complaining (a distorted memory of bondage, a heart of discontent, and a distorted view of the past), ingratitude, desire for fleshly satisfaction

The destroyer 1 Corinthians 10:10: The serpent, death, judgement, misery

A heart that complains about things, situations and people is stuck in the past, is rebellious, and resists growth. A heart that gives thanks trusts that "all things work together for good" (Romans 8:28). Our posture determines the results we see. Gratitude opens the door to transformation; complaining invites ruin and eventual death.
