From East:

- PA Turnpike to Breezewood, exit 161
- US route 30 West to Everett
- Continue into town, turning left at first light onto PA route 26 South
- The road to the range is the very first right after passing through the Turnpike underpass. Approximately ¼ mile back road to tan colored building.

From North:

- I-99 South to Bedford
- US route 30 East to Everett
- Continue into town, turning right at the second light onto PA route 26 South
- The road to the range is the very first right after passing through the Turnpike underpass. Approximately ¼ mile back road to tan colored building.

From West:

- PA Turnpike to Bedford, exit 146
- I-99 South to Bedford
- US route 30 East to Everett
- Continue into town, turning right at the second light onto PA route 26 South
- The road to the range is the very first right after passing through the Turnpike underpass. Approximately ¼ mile back road to tan colored building.

RULES: Current NRA Smallbore Rifle rules will govern.

Current NRA Precision Air Rifle rules will govern.

COMPETITION OPEN TO:

Any member of PIAA sanctioned 3-P high school rifle team, or a student of any Pennsylvania high school that has been selected by his/her high school's athletic director to represent their school is eligible. A letter of authorization must be submitted to the match director if the competitor is not a member of a PIAA sanctioned team. Each school may send a maximum of four competitors.

ENTRIES:

Relay reservations are open effective immediately. Email the match director to select your relay. Relays will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis. Entries are closed at the end of the day on Monday February 10th, 2025. The up-to-date relay reservation sheet can be seen with QR code below or the following link.

All registrations will be completed online. The link to the form will be sent once relay reservations are made. This form must be submitted by Tuesday February 11th, 2025. Letter of authorization for individual participants may be emailed to the match director in advance or submitted during match check-in. Payment for all must be turned in during match check-in to be eligible to participate. Checks are to be made out to *Everett Rifle Club Association*.

Participants will be competing as individuals. If a school selects to enter the team competition, the team score will be determined by the sum of the four individuals from that school. Separate targets will not be fired for the team competition.

ENTRY FEE:

\$60 per team (4-person team) for each event.

If competing in both air **and** smallbore, it is a \$120 fee.

\$15 per individual for each event.

If competing in both air **and** smallbore, it is a \$30 fee.

ENTRY LIMIT:

Accepted to 9 competitors per relay, leaving 1 hospital point. Air rifle relays can be changed to smallbore to accommodate competitors if needed.

A limited number of air rifles are available for use for additional participation in the air rifle match. Contact the match director to setup if interested in using these guns. **AWARDS:**

- Plaque to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place smallbore and air rifle teams
- Medals to members of placewinning teams
- Medals to top 6 individuals smallbore and air rifle
- Medals to top 3 in each smallbore position

Relay times reflect the start of changeover/prep time. Competitors will be called to the range 10 minutes prior to the start of the relay for the safety briefing.

MATCH COURSE OF FIRE:

3-Position Smallbore, Half Course

- 5 minute changeover + 3 minute preparation period
- 20 minutes for 20 record shots in prone
- 5 minute changeover + 3 minute preparation period
- 40 minutes for 20 record shots in standing
- 5 minute changeover + 3 minute preparation period
- 30 minutes for 20 record shots in kneeling

Precision Air Rifle, 60 Shots Standing

- 3 minute preparation period
- 83 minutes for 60 record in standing

TARGETS AND SCORING:

Athena Electronic Scoring Targets will be utilized for both the smallbore and air rifle competitions. As the NRA rulebook does not specify target heights for EST targets, Athena instead uses the target heights specified by the CMP rulebook.

- 500mm for prone
- 800mm for kneeling
- 1400mm for standing

Scores will be uploaded automatically online to the Scopos Rezults match pages. The QR codes below can be scanned to review results at any point, or search "Everett Sportsmans Junior Rifle Club" at rezults.scopos.tech.





TIES:

All ties will be broken in accordance with NRA rules built into the Orion software.

SCORING CHALLENGES:

Individual shots must be validated prior to advancing. Issues must immediately be brought to the attention of the match director/statistical officer for resolution prior to shooting the next record shot. No further protests will be accepted once subsequent shots have occurred.

COACHING:

Coaching is prohibited. If a competitor wishes to speak with his/her coach, the competitor must make his/her rifle safe and leave the firing line, being careful not to disturb other competitors. It is permissible for one coach per team entry to remain in the range.

OTHER:

- Hearing protection is required by all individuals in the range. Eye protection is recommended but not required.
- Food will be available to purchase but is not permitted in the range area.
- All cell phones must be silenced in the range.
- Compressed air is available at the range at no charge. Please bring your own cylinder adapters.

APPAREL ORDER:

Championship apparel is available to preorder at the link and QR code listed below. Orders are due online by 1/31/2025 and will be available for pickup during the championship.
