



## WINES BY THE GLASS

### White

<b>Dr. L Riesling 2019 Germany</b>	\$6.00
It is a bright, vibrant, fruit-driven wine, with a juicy mid-palate and a crisp, drying finish.	
<b>Attems Pinot Grigio 2020 Italy</b>	\$7.00
In its structured body we find a wine with a balanced, complex flavor and a persistent finish of white pepper, avocado and walnut.	
<b>Loveblock Sauvignon Blanc 2021 New Zealand</b>	\$8.00
Dense fruit core of juicy melon and peach complemented by hints of ripe herbs and florals.; plenty of minerality, citrus, ripe stone fruit and an umami quality.	
<b>Cliff Lede Sauvignon Blanc 2021 California</b>	\$9.00
Exhilarating bouquet of lemon curd, honeysuckle nectar, and white peach aromas. Layers of shortbread, beeswax, flint, and kaffir lime scents appear with time and heighten the complexity.	
<b>William Fevre Chablis Champs Royaux 2020 France</b>	\$12.00
Very fresh bouquet with notes of citrus and white fleshed fruit, with a very slightly oaky finish. Fresh and supple, the wine is marked by mineral notes that are typical of the appellation.	

<b>Sonoma Cutrer Russian River Chardonnay 2019 California</b>	\$9.00
Fruit forward bouquet of bosc pear, Honeycrisp apple and a subtle hint of citrus blossom. Delicate whiffs of nougat, roasted nuts and oak spice accentuate the tantalizing fruit scents.	
<b>Liquid Farm White Hill Chardonnay 2019 California</b>	\$14.00
Wild, exotic wine. Freshly cut flowers, mint, peach, crushed rocks and slate all race across the palate.	
<b>Domaine des Baumard Savennieres 2018 France</b>	\$13.00
An intense dry wine, with structure and complexity. The white fruits and minerality come through this structured body, yet have an appealing roundness that becomes more apparent with air and time.	

### Rosé

<b>Peyrassol Les Commandeurs Rosé 2021 France</b>	\$9.00
A soft color reminiscent of rose petals. A beautiful nose of English candy, strawberry and raspberry aromas followed by light redcurrant and citrus notes. Marked by the complexity of red and exotic fruit flavors,	
<b>Schramsberg Mirabelle Rose Brut NV California</b>	\$12.00
Delicate and pretty, with expressive orange blossom and strawberry flavors laced with brioche and spiced nuts.	
<b>Laurent-Perrier Cuvee Rosé NV France</b>	\$20.00
intensely fruity flavors, clean and slightly sharp sensation of freshly picked red berries: strawberries, Morello cherries, black currants and raspberries. The finish is supple and rounded	

### Sparkling

<b>Bisot Prosecco NV Italy</b>	\$7.00
Brilliant straw yellow color; perlage extremely fine and lively. Intense and fresh nose of citrus fruits	
<b>Roederer Estate Brut NV California</b>	\$11.00
Extremely fresh and floral with sliced apples, stones and some white peach. Bread dough, too. Fine bead. Medium to full body with crisp acidity and a steely finish.	
<b>Gaston Chiquet NV Brut Champagne NV France</b>	\$16.00
Vibrant and balanced, with flavors of nectarine, candied orange peel, slivered almond and oyster shell set on a lacy texture. Fragrant hints of white blossoms and lemon thyme show on the finish.

<b>Magnolia Pinot Noir 2020 California</b> Aromas of dried cherry, raspberry and pomegranate. Light to medium-bodied with fine tannin and hints of oak.	<b>\$9.00</b>
<b>Cloudline Pinot Noir 2021 Oregon</b> Part of the Domaine Drouhin Oregon portfolio, medium ruby-purple in the glass, it's scented of cranberries, blackberries and blueberries with touches of tar, mushroom and lavender.	<b>\$10.00</b>
<b>Hartford Court Russian River Pinot Noir 2021 California</b> A beautiful wine with soft red fruit notes and seductive on the palate; silky smooth and lots of elegant up front fruit.	<b>\$14.00</b>
<b>Domaine Nicolas Rossignol Bourgogne 2018 France</b> Aromas of black cherries, raspberries and earth. Bright, fresh and juicy; flavors of raspberries and baking spices.	<b>\$10.00</b>
<b>Clos du Caillou Côtes du Rhône 2020 France</b> Dark red color with touches of purple. Aromas of thyme and rosemary, paired with blackberries and wild raspberries.	<b>\$11.00</b>
<b>Hall Napa Valley Merlot 2018 California</b> Deep ruby in color, tempting nose with hints of violet, ripe cherry and warm baking spices. The palate is supple with layers of brambly red fruits, cocoa, and dusty tannins. Finishes long and vibrant with lingering notes of graphite.	<b>\$14.00</b>
<b>Luca Old Vines Malbec 2018 Argentina</b> Blueberries and black tea with volcanic salt and violets on the nose and palate. Medium to full body.	<b>\$10.00</b>
<b>Brolio Ricasoli Brolio Chianti Classico Riserva 2019 Italy</b> Intense ruby red color. Rich and complex nose, which recalls ripe red fruits, spices and sweet notes of vanilla. In the mouth, it is voluminous, with structured, appreciable tannins. Long and persistent finish.	<b>\$12.00</b>
<b>Produttori del Barbaresco Barbaresco 2018 Italy</b> The aromas are bold and ripe with dark and purple fruit, but the bouquet shows interesting twists with earth, truffle, licorice and grilled herb.	<b>\$15.00</b>
<b>R. Lopez de Heredia Vina Bosconia Reserva 2010 Spain</b> Eighty percent tempranillo, fleshed out with garnacha, graciano and mazuelo, a smooth, chocolatey Rioja in 2010 with plump blueberry, plum and rosehip flavors. It's riper and a little rustic	<b>\$13.00</b>
<b>Turley Juvenile Zinfandel 2021 California</b> Fragrant, lifted aromas of ripe dark fruits like black raspberry and blood orange on the nose. Superb balance between acidity, tannin, and spice, with a succulent, profoundly satisfying texture.	<b>\$11.00</b>
<b>Cocodrillo Red Blend 2019 Argentina</b> Deep ruby red color. Fruity, spicy and elegant character. Notes of blueberries, fresh plums, dark chocolate, and sweet spices. Full-bodied, with fine-grained tannins. Long persistence.	<b>\$11.00</b>
<b>Château de Cérons Graves Bordeaux 2018 France</b> Well structured, rich with dense tannins and juicy with black-currant flavors..	<b>\$12.00</b>
<b>Details Sonoma County Cabernet Sauvignon 2019 California</b> Delivers elegance, depth, and power in one stunning wine. Enticing aromas of violets and ripe raspberries are followed by notes of sage, allspice, and a touch of balsamic reduction.	<b>\$12.00</b>
<b>Frank Family Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon 2019 California</b> aromas of black cherry, cassis, and vanilla welcome you into the glass.
