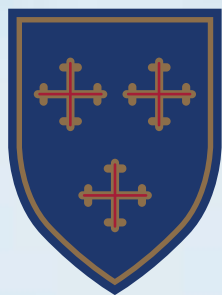

# HONORARY COIN TOSS



## **DON GRAVES**

DON GRAVES ENLISTED IN THE MARINE CORPS AT 17 IN 1942, SERVING THROUGH INTENSE WORLD WAR II COMBAT, INCLUDING THE BATTLE OF IWO JIMA AS A FLAMETHROWER OPERATOR. OF THE 335 MARINES IN HIS BATTALION, ONLY 18 SURVIVED IWO JIMA, WHERE GRAVES WITNESSED THE ICONIC FLAG RAISING AT MOUNT SURIBACHI. HIS FAITH, DISCOVERED AMID THE BATTLE, LED HIM TO DEDICATE 32 YEARS TO MINISTRY AFTER THE WAR. GRAVES' LEGACY IS ONE OF COURAGE, RESILIENCE, AND FAITH, HONORING THE MEMORY OF HIS FALLEN COMRADES.

## **PAUL A. SMITH SR.**

PAUL A. SMITH SR. JOINED THE DALLAS POLICE DEPARTMENT IN 2014 AFTER 26 YEARS IN THE US ARMY, RISING TO FIRST SERGEANT. KNOWN FOR HIS LEADERSHIP, HE SERVES ON THE BOARD OF THE HW3 FOUNDATION, A YOUTH BOOT CAMP FOCUSING ON DISCIPLINE, FITNESS, AND STEM. AN IRONMAN ATHLETE AND MARATHONER, PAUL IS ALSO PURSUING A DOCTORATE IN EDUCATION, K-12 LEADERSHIP.



## **CAPTAIN JAMES HILL**

CPT JAMES F. HILL, A DISTINGUISHED U.S. ARMY OFFICER, GRADUATED FROM THE UNITED STATES MILITARY ACADEMY IN 2015 WITH A DEGREE IN MECHANICAL ENGINEERING. HE SERVED WITH THE 82ND AIRBORNE DIVISION AND DEPLOYED TO IRAQ IN 2017, PLAYING A KEY ROLE IN OPERATION INHERENT RESOLVE TO RECLAIM MOSUL FROM ISIS. AFTER HIS IRAQ DEPLOYMENT, HE COMMANDED A UNIT IN ALASKA'S 17TH COMBAT SUSTAINMENT SUPPORT BATTALION. CPT HILL LATER EARNED AN MBA FROM THE COLLEGE OF WILLIAM & MARY AND NOW SERVES IN THE DALLAS-FORT WORTH RECRUITING BATTALION. A QUALIFIED PARATROOPER, HE EXEMPLIFIES A DEEP COMMITMENT TO LEADERSHIP AND SERVICE. HIS MILITARY ACCOLADES INCLUDE THE BRONZE STAR MEDAL, MERITORIOUS SERVICE MEDAL, ARMY COMMENDATION MEDAL, AND IRAQ CAMPAIGN MEDAL.

## **MILTON WILLIAMS**

MILTON WILLIAMS, DIRECTOR OF DEVELOPMENT AT THE KRODLE FOUNDATION, BRINGS OVER 30 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE FROM THE DALLAS FIRE DEPARTMENT. AFTER 34 YEARS OF SERVICE, MILTON RETIRED BUT REMAINED COMMITTED TO HELPING OTHERS. HAVING WORKED ALONGSIDE TODD KRODLE, MILTON JOINED THE FOUNDATION TO HONOR FALLEN FIREFIGHTERS AND SUPPORT THE COMMUNITY. AS DIRECTOR, HE PLAYS A KEY ROLE IN ADVANCING THE FOUNDATION'S MISSION, ENSURING SWIFT, IMPACTFUL SUPPORT FOR THOSE IN NEED.
