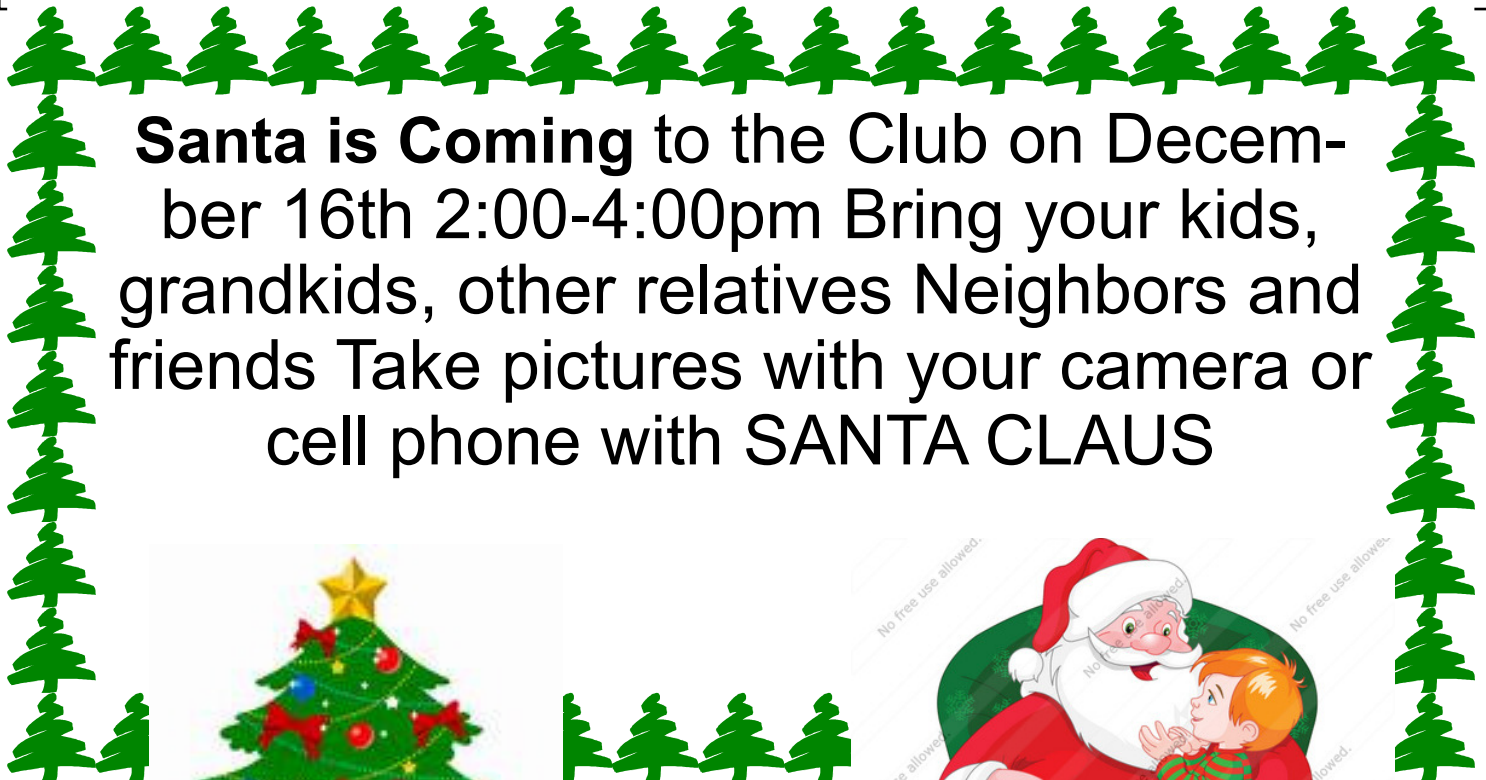

Nominations Committee

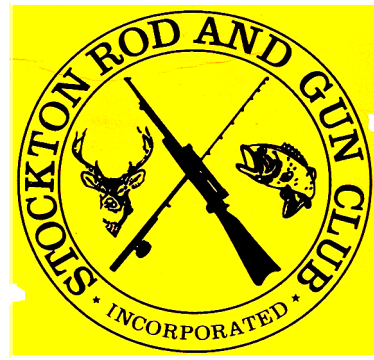
Board members leaving the board after this year terms are: Amanda Beghtel, Dennis Morgan, Linda Black

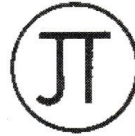

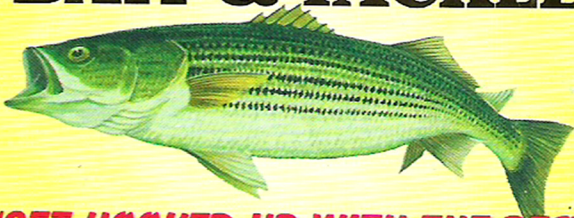

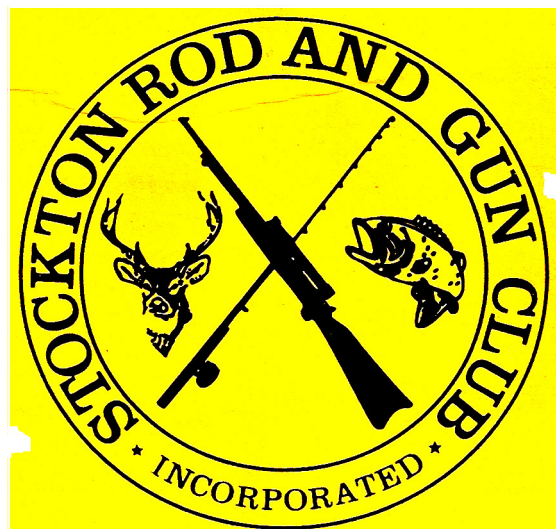
