They are serving Flautas Rice Beans Salad Chips and Salsa. Well be served about noon on Saturday May 5th \$8 a plate



- 11. You are responsible for your guests. They must leave the club when you do.**


**We would like you to enjoy all of the facilities and to become an active member of your club. It is our opinion that more active you become, the more you will enjoy the functions and the members.**






