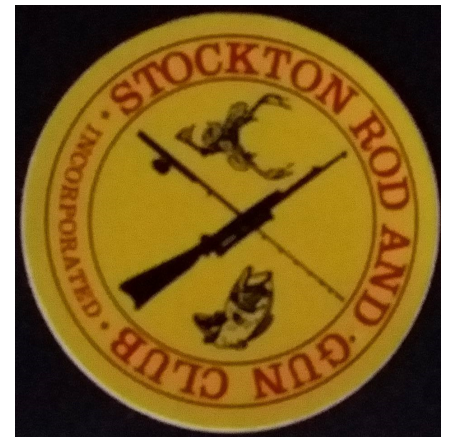

We would like you to enjoy all of the facilities and to become an active member of your club. It is our opinion that more active you become, the more you will enjoy the functions and the members.

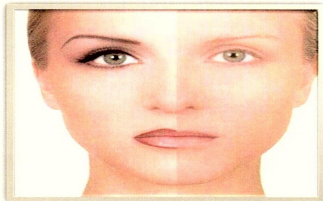

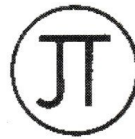

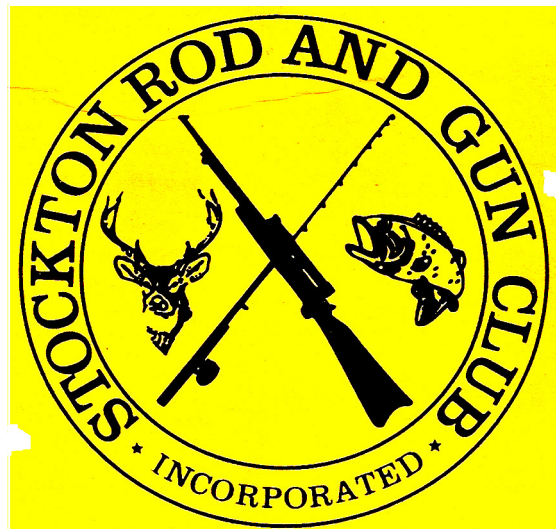
