Point Weber left on August 14th. Pat, the new owner of the vessel, donated life vests and are in the black box near the gangway.



Fishing Report

DELTA— Striped bass continue to migrate into the Sacramento side of the Delta, and they are scattered from Suisun Bay north into Liberty Island. A large school is found between Rio Vista and Collinsville, and trollers along the West Bank are catching and releasing numbers of legal fish. The grass has been a deterrent, and the best action without having to constantly clear lines has been as the tide slows down. In the north Delta around Liberty Island, the stripers and largemouth bass are feeding in the shallows, and the largemouth are starting to orient to structure, particularly wood. Flipping or punching in the grass are the top techniques. White sturgeon will reopen for catch-and-release only after a review by the Office of Administrative Law expected to take place by early September.


