The month wrapped up with a fantastic Halloween Party, full of fun, laughter, and great costumes.

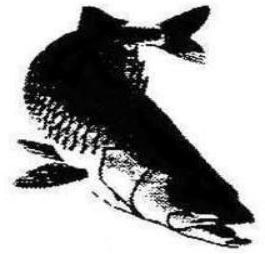

Club Business & Meetings

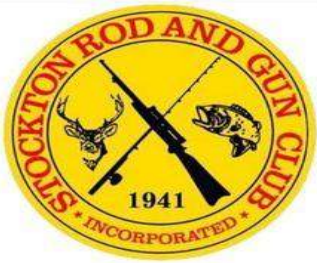
The Board met this month to discuss ongoing maintenance, hall rental pricing, and upcoming events.

A special Board session was held before the membership meeting to handle a few urgent items.

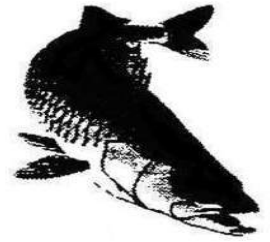
Members are encouraged to attend future meetings to stay informed and involved in club operations.
