Fishing Report Updated Oct. 8, 2023: California Delta: DELTA, San Joaquin side — Striped bass continue to happen on both the Sacramento and San Joaquin sides of the Delta, and Jeff Soo Hoo of Soo Hoo Sport Fishing out of Lauritzen's Yacht Harbor in Oakley reported great action on the San Joaquin drifting live mudsuckers for quality linesides. The stripers are schooled up enough that live bite is now an option. With schools of stripers still in San Francisco Bay and the amount of shad in the Delta, this fall has the possibility to be outstanding for striped bass. Largemouth bass action has been tough for some while others are finding solid fishing. Fresno-native Vince Borges of Vince Borges Outdoors reported finding better fish on paddletail swimbaits in shad patterns since 'there are shad everywhere.' Punching, frogs, or chatterbaits are also working, but the best fish are coming on the swimbaits. He added, "The bite is kind of tough, but we saw plenty of good fish, and my partner, Chad Frie, landed one at 7.70 pounds. The stripers are chasing bait in the south Delta, and they are busting bait on surface with the birds working. You can pick out around 10 fish before they scatter and pop up again further up or down stream. The water temperature is still warm at 76 degrees in the south Delta."


