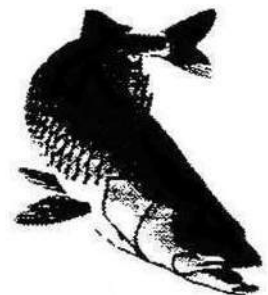
Reminder
