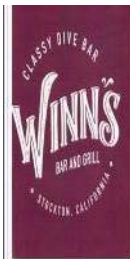

DELTA, San Joaquin side — The first of the big frog tournaments took place out of Russo's Marina, and a total of 162 teams participated in either the pro or amateur divisions of the Ultimate Frog Challenge 2. The winning limit at 31.77 pounds with a big fish of 8.91 pound by the team of Hung Ho/Mon Luong topped the field by over 3 pounds. The colder conditions on Sunday morning made for a more challenging frog bite as the water temperature dropped a few degrees and it was foggy in the morning. The original frog tournament, the Snag Proof Open, is this weekend out of Russo's, and in addition to Snag Proof or American Bait Works topwater frogs, the new Zoo Dog, Zoo Pup, and Zoo Pop are also allowed. More big bass are starting to show up on a variety of techniques, and the best windows are in the early mornings or evenings.
