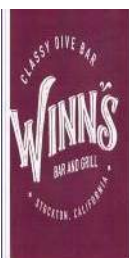

Fishing Report

DELTA, Sacramento Side — The Sacramento River remains muddy in the main channel, but male striped bass are already milking as the recent weather conditions have spurred on the upcoming spawn. Finding clear water in locations such as the Mokelumne River is a key, and the swimbait and glide bait for stripers is ready to break out. Largemouth bass is also best in the clear waters of the Mokelumne. Sturgeon fishing remains tremendous in Suisun Bay, and six-pack operators are providing multiple opportunities for their customers to fight undersized, slot-limit, and oversized diamondbacks. Cured salmon roe remains the top bait.
