- Fishing line does not break down in nature (even when put correctly in landfill) and we have a lot of old fishing line on property.
- As a basic conservation step, we should recycle, nearest recycle station is Buckley Cove Marina.
- Berkeley (fishing products) recycles line at no cost (just shipping).
- Materials for 2 recycle tubes have been donated. 1 on the hill and 1 at the docks.
- So, lets do our part, clean up and use them going forward for the health of our waterways. Fishing line only please (all types OK).

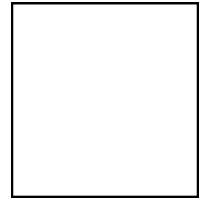
