## **Fishing Report**

DELTA, Sacramento Side — The water temperature has dropped from 52 to 47 degrees within the week, and the water clarity has also been reduced to around a foot in the main Sacramento River. Trolling has been slow, but there is the occasional quality lineside taken on deep-diving lures along the West Bank. Fresh run stripers continue to move in from the bay, and anglers are fishing success soaking live mudsuckers or frozen shad on the anchor at 30 feet in depth near Collinsville. The stripers are moving north with the stained water, and the Liberty Island area is picking up with swimbaits in the shallows. Sturgeon fishing remains outstanding in Suisun Bay with cured salmon roe, but few six-pack boats have been running with the emergency regulations limiting the slot size and annual bag limit.




