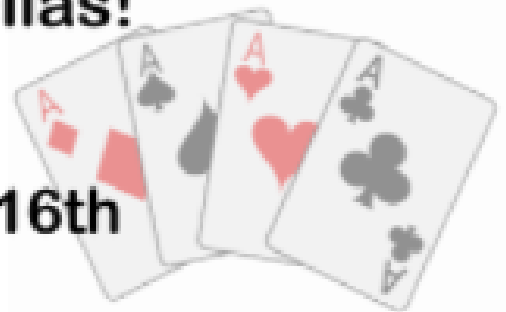

## 1. Article V Board of Directors #1

Vacancies in the Board of Directors shall automatically be filled by the first runner up from the election of officers if available, or by special election for the remaining term.

## 2. Article XIV Membership

### #2

(Change) Application not to exceed \$200.00 initiation and \$300.00 yearly dues (not to exceed \$500.00 total)

(Present) Any Member may serve on a committee of choice.

(Change/Add) Any member and Spouse/Partner may rent the hall at the reduced rate once per year, for immediate family use only.

### #6

(Add) Any member or spouse/partner may serve on a committee of choice.

### #7

(Add) New Member to receive – New Application – Referral Card

### #10

(Change) Shall be limited to (500) Five Hundred active members

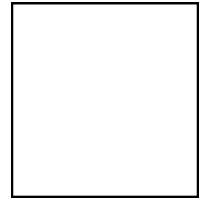
