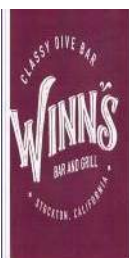

Also, thank you Steven Orozco and John Freeman for the chicken and fettuccine dinner at the last general meeting!

Our board of directors meeting was held 6/27 in lieu of 7/4 due to the holiday. We had three new members. There are nine prospective members. Please note, bartenders have been made aware dues cannot be accepted by new members until board has approved. We will have our general membership meeting 7/11 with meatloaf, mashed potatoes, and corn on the cob by Karen Geyer for \$15 per plate.

We're celebrating our Independence Day with a waterslide, and BBQ potluck party. We will have burgers and hot dogs but please bring a side dish to share. The club will open at 12:00.
