Yo-zuri, and p-line predator lures are the preferred option for most on the troll. Cut sardines, or anchovies are great for bait fishing. Try to utilize jerk baits, swimbaits, glide baits, or zara spooks for casting lures.

LAKE AMADOR

RATING - GOOD

The lake is at a very high level for this time of year surprisingly. There are a lot trout cruising shallow in the early mornings. Not as many limits coming out right now, but fish are being caught daily and some are of very good size. The boat dock, the dam, and the launch channel have all been turning out nice fish lately. 


