

## **Fishing Report**

DELTA, Sacramento Side — The water remains high and cold, but when the tides are smaller, the water clears up around the West Bank from the Rio Vista Bridge to Collinsville and trolling is vastly improved. The striped bass are migrating both in and through the Delta on their way to the upper river to spawn. Largemouth bass action is best in the north Delta with Senkos off of the shorelines as the majority of bass are in post-spawn mode. Sturgeon fishing remains solid out of Pittsburg with cured salmon roe, but few six-packs remain in the area. Anglers are requested to release the large gravid females on their way to spawn in the upper river.

DELTA, San Joaquin side — Striped bass fishing continues to be outstanding for those drifting jumbo minnows, tossing Optimum's Bad Bubba Shad swimbaits, spooning, or drifting live bluegill. The schools move frequently with fresh fish moving in and out on a daily basis. It is a matter of covering lots of water and looking at certain periods of tidal movement.. Largemouth bass action has been hampered by the cold water from the heavy snowmelt along with significan predation from sea lions while the large female fish are vulnerable on their beds. The bass are trying to spawn, but the water remains cold. Over 150 solid anglers participated in the Wild West Pro/Am tournament over three days with only one limit breaking 20 pounds. The south San Joaquin River below Mossdale remains high and muddy, and action is limited to cut bait for catfish and the occasional striper.




