Fishing Report

DELTA, Sacramento Side — Sturgeon fishing remains best in Suisun Bay from Pittsburg to the Benicia/Martinez Bridge, and the best action is coming during the larger tides. Cured salmon eggs is the best bait, but ghost shrimp or lamprey eel are starting to produce. Striped bass are found either in Suisun Bay on bait or upriver from Cache Slough to the Sacramento Deep Water Channel for trollers. Both species will be turning on as the water continues to clear and warm.

DELTA, San Joaquin side —What a difference a week makes as a 16-pound plus limit took this Saturday's tournament compared to a 2-fish 6-pound limit the previous week. The best bass action has been by flipping plastics in the stained water as it is slightly warmer than the clearer water. The south Delta has cleared considerably within the week of clear weather. Striped bass are moving into the Delta, and with the high water, it will be outstanding within a few weeks.

New Fishing License Info 365-Day Sport Fishing Licenses


(valid January 1, through December 31, 2023, if purchased between November 15, 2022 and December 31, 2022, or for 365 days if purchased after January 1, 2023)

A sport fishing license is required for any person attempting to take fish, mollusks, crustaceans, invertebrates, amphibians, or reptiles in inland or ocean waters. Additional validations and report cards are required for certain species and areas.


