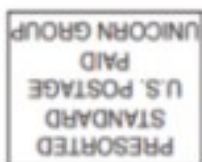

- APR 4, 1941 20 YEAR LEASE ON CLUB SITE
- APR 7, 1944 COMPLETION OF ROOM ON PORCH FOR CARETAKER
- APR 21, 1944 3RD \$500 WAR BOND BY THE CLUB, \$5 ATTENDANCE PRICE DISCONTINUED
- APR 6, 1951 6 ACRES FOR ARCHERY RANGE, JR SPORTSEM, \$1 YEAR UNTIL 16 THEN INTO R&G FOR \$3, NO INITIATION FEE
- APR 20, 1951 COOLERS ON ROOF, NETS OUT OF RIVER
- APR 16, 1954 LARGEST STURGEON OB RECORD 1900 POUNDS CAUGHT IN ASTORIA OREGON
- APR 28, 1955 OUTBOARD CLUB CHANGED ITS NAME TO BOAT CLUB
- APR, MAY 1958 BOATERS CALLED OUT OF BED FOR POSSIBLE EVACUATION WORK DUE TO FLOODING- WAS DIRECTED BY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT OFFICE AT LINDSAY & HUNTER
- APR 6, 1960 CLUB WORK PARTY-REPAIR DOCKS AND RAMP

## Fishing Report: March 20, 2025

### **RATING - FAIR**

Largemouth bass action has been tough for some while others are finding solid fishing. Striper fishing remain slow on the east delta, but if you are into pan fish fishing, Red Ear Sunfish can be found in 8 mile slough and whiskey slough using red worms.
