Step Two Option 1:

Patient chooses to establish care with a Modern Day Health Care Provider, to be evaluated for a qualifying medical condition.



Step One: Patient has been diagnosed with a qualifying medical condition.



Step Two Option 2: The patient chooses to obtain a referral from their Primary Care Provider along with medical records for their qualifying medical condition.

Step Three: Patient's referral and or previous medical records are sent to Modern Day Health Care (fax or printed copies ONLY) for review by a Modern Day Health Care Provider.

Step Five: Patient receives an email from the State of South Dakota to create an account on medcannibisapplication. sd.gov. Once complete, the patient must wait for DOH approval.
