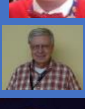

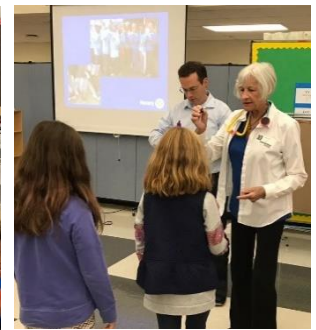
October 22, 23, 24 and 25 –
