Last weeks speaker was Julie Young grant writer, mom and writer for Lake Norman Macaroni Kid. If your looking for fun things to do with the family check out their website.



Lake Norman Men That Cook


Sunday March 31 - 11 am to 2 pm at Langtree Plantation
